1. Heard Mr. B. Dutta, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Ms. L. Rongpipi, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Mr. K.K. Parasar, learned APP for the State of Assam.

2. This I.A. has been filed praying for suspension of the impugned Judgment dated 27.06.2025 and Order dated 30.06.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (FTC) No. 2, Tinsukia, in Sessions Case No. 52(CH)/2021, whereby the appellants have been convicted under Sections 341/432/304(II)/34 of the IPC and sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 10 years and to pay a fine of Rs. 50,000/-, along with other sentences as indicated in the order itself.

3. The learned counsel for the parties is in consensus that Criminal Appeal No. 353/2025 may be taken up for disposal on 28.01.2026, since the trial court records have already been received.
