Heard Mr. B Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By filing this writ petition, the petitioner is seeking for a direction to the respondents to pay Rs.9,07,800.93/-, which is the 12% interest on the delayed payment of pensionary benefits to the petitioner.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in 4(four) weeks' time.

Mr. A.R. Tahbildar, the learned Standing Counsel, Higher Education Department accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2. Therefore, no formal notice need be issued to the said respondents.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall, however, serve the requisite copies of the writ petition along with annexures to the learned counsel for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 within a period of 3(three) days from today.

In so far as the respondent Nos.3 and 4 are concerned, the learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps for service of notice by registered post with A/D within a period of 3(three) days from today.
