ORDER

Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that the matter was last listed before the Hon'ble Court on 26.05.2025. On that day, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. B. Sinha, prayed before the Hon'ble Court to take fresh steps for service of notice upon respondent Nos. 3 & 4. Accordingly, the Hon'ble Court granted two weeks to the petitioner for taking the necessary steps.

Pursuant to the order stated above, it appears that the petitioner has taken fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 3 by way registered post with A/D on 09.06.2025. But, no steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 4 have been received from the petitioner.

Further, it has been observed that the A/D card (***annexed at Flag-'AD' in the Part-III file***) of respondent No. 3 has been received bearing the purported signature and the official seal of the respondent. As such, it may be said that **service of notice upon the respondent No. 3 has been completed.**

Now, as for the respondent No. 4 [***i.e., The Accountant General (A&E), Assam***], it has been observed that learned counsel, Mr. D. Bhattacharya has already appeared before the

Hon'ble Court on 26.05.2025 representing the A.G, Assam. Also, it appears that an acceptance notice **(at Flag-'AN')** regarding service of notice upon the learned Standing Counsel, AG has been filed. As such, it may be said that **service of notice upon the respondent No. 4 has been completed as well.**

In light of the above observations, the matter may be placed before the Hon'ble Court for necessary orders.
