Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Addl. P.P., Assam.

This is an application filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, praying for granting of pre-arrest bail in respect of the accused/petitioner, namely Swapna Gill, in connection with Silchar P.S Case No. 473/2025, under Section- 126(2)/296/3(5)/109/118(2) of BNS.

It is submitted that the accused Nos. 2 and 3 have already been granted bail by the learned CJM, Cachar. It is further submitted that the present petitioner is a woman having two children.

The allegation as reflected in the FIR is that the petitioner and accused persons are neighbours and they have been harassing the informant and her family members and also attacked the son of the informant with sharp weapon.

The specific allegation is against the accused No. 1, i.e., Bikram Gill. However, the present petitioner, Sapna Gill, is the mother of the accused No. 1 and there is no specific material against her, although the medical report indicates grievous injury.

Having regard to the above, the prayer for pre-arrest bail is allowed.

Accordingly, the interim order dated 30.10.2025 is hereby made absolute subject to the same terms and conditions.

It is further provided that since the charge sheet has been submitted, the petitioner shall participate in the trial regularly.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
