The petitioner herein is aggrieved by the imposition of penalty under Rule 21(b) of the Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969 whereby his monthly pension has been permanently stopped.

2. The petitioner retired on 28.02.2021 and Mr. A.T. Sarkar, the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the matter requires an urgent and expeditious disposal, taking into account that the petitioner who has retired has no source of income without the pension.

3. Accordingly, list this matter again on 19.03.2026 at 2.00 P.M.
4. The respondents shall produce the records of the departmental proceeding on the said date.
5. An attempt shall be made to dispose of the writ petition on the next date.
