Heard Mr. N. Haque, learned counsel for the petitioners, who submits that the petitioners have filed this instant writ petition seeking a direction to the respondent authorities concerned to provincialise services in terms of the recommendation made by the Independent Authority of the Districts which was forwarded to the Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Department of School Education (Annexure-8) wherein, at the end of the statements the same is dated 23.12.2024. The learned counsel submits that the services of the petitioners could not be provincialised at the relevant time along with similarly situated persons on account of certain spelling mistakes in their names. However, the same has been rectified in terms of the report of the Independent Authorities and therefore the petitioners are entitled to be provincialised in their service.

In view of above, issue notice of motion returnable by 3(three) weeks.

Mr. U. Sarma, learned Standing Counsel, Secondary Education Department accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4; Mr. B. Deuri, learned Govt. Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

Petitioners to serve requisite copies of the Writ Petition to the learned counsel appearing for the respondents today within 3(three) days.

Pendency of the writ petition shall not be a bar for the respondents to act

upon the recommendation of the Independent Authorities for provincialising services of the petitioners.
