Pursuant to the order dated 29.10.2025, Mr. K. Gogoi, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent Authorities has placed before this Court a set of instructions. The said instructions are collectively kept on record and marked with the letter 'X'.

2. From a perusal of the said instructions, it appears that the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Zone-III, Tezpur, Sonitpur has requested the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonitpur to initiate proceedings for recovery of the awarded amount of Rs.6,42,809.26p along with interest at the rate of 9% on the said amount from 02.05.2018 till realization. In addition to that, the recovery certificate has also been issued on 19.11.2025.

3. Ms. M. Das, the learned counsel who appears on behalf of

the respondent No.5 submitted that the respondent No.5 would like to settle out the dispute by making the due payment to which the petitioner herein is entitled to.

4. Taking into account the above, list this matter on 03.12.2025.

5. Mr. A. Ganguly, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has already furnished during the course of the hearing the bank details of the petitioner.

6. The respondent No. 5 is given the liberty to make the payment to the petitioner. Failing which appropriate directions would be passed for continuation of the proceedings before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonitpur.
