Learned counsel Mr. S. Islam appears on behalf of Mr. M. Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 1 to 8 via registered post with A/D mode on 17.12.2018.

Meanwhile, it appears that learned counsels have entered appearance on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 6 & 8 by filing their Vakalatnama. Accordingly, **service of notice upon the aforementioned respondents (i.e., respondent Nos. 1 to 6 & 8) is deemed complete.**

Further, in respect of the notice issued to the remaining respondent, i.e., respondent No. 7, it has been observed that neither the A/D card nor any un-served notice has been received by the registry. Additionally, the postal tracking report is unavailable in the official website of India Post. Consequently, service of notice upon respondent No. 7 cannot be presumed at this stage.

However, ***learned counsel Mr. S. Islam, appearing on behalf of the petitioner, submits that the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant case. Accordingly, the learned counsel has prayed for the matter to be placed before the Hon'ble Court.***
