2. Mr. G. Bokolial, the learned Government Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 and Mr. B. Gogoi, the learned Additional Advocate General who is also the Standing Counsel of the Finance Department appears on behalf of the respondent No. 2 and accepts notice.
3. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon the respective counsels during the course of the day.
4. The instant writ petition has been filed being aggrieved by

the inaction on the part of the Respondent Authorities in not making payment amounting to Rs. 8,39,390/- to the petitioner.

5. The case of the petitioner herein is that the petitioner is the registered owner of a vehicle bearing Registration No. AS-09AC-3219 [TATA 407 (Water Tank)]. The Respondent Authorities hired the petitioner's vehicle on different dates for their emergency use. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted the bills before the authorities for release of his dues amounting to Rs. 8,39,390/-. It is the further case of the petitioner that he had also submitted representations dated 21.05.2025 and 30.06.2025 requesting for payment of the bills, however, the said amounts have not been released to the petitioner. It is under such circumstances, the petitioner has approached this Court.

6. The respondents are directed to bring on record their stand by filing the affidavits on or before 16.02.2026.
