2. Ms. U. Das, the learned Additional Senior Government Advocate appears on behalf of all the respondents and accepts notice.
3. Extra copies of the writ petition be served upon her during the course of the day.
4. The case of the petitioner herein is that the petitioner is the registered owner of a vehicle bearing Registration No. AS-09G-1958 [Bolero (Power)], which was taken on hire by the

respondent No. 5 for its official use, with an assurance that payment for such hire would be made. The said vehicle was used for various periods from 01.01.2021 to 31.08.2023, and the petitioner accordingly submitted bills for the said periods, totaling Rs. 13,80,106/-, which were duly acknowledged by the authorities. Thereafter, the petitioner personally approached the authorities on different dates and also submitted representations on 21.05.2025 and 30.06.2025. However, as the aforesaid amount has not been paid, the petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

5. The respondents are directed to bring on record their stand by filing the affidavits on or before 02.03.2026.
