Heard Mr. B. Choudhury, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and

Mr. B. Sarma, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for the State respondent, who has produced the case diary in the matter.

This anticipatory bail application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 has been filed by the petitioners, namely, **(1) Sanowar Kazi, (2) Manwowar Kazi @ Kazi Monawar Hussain and (3) Anowar Kazi @ Kazi Anowar Hussain**, seeking privilege of pre-arrest bail, apprehending their arrest in connection with **Tarabari P.S. Case No. 58/2025** under Sections 21(b)/ 29 of the NDPS Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no recovery from the petitioners of any contraband and they have not been named by any of the arrested co-accused in the alleged offences.

Perusal of the case diary shows that there is statement made regarding the presence of the petitioners and one of the owner vehicles by some of the witnesses.

Under the given facts and circumstances and the materials available in the case diary, this Court is not inclined at this stage to grant the prayer of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners keeping in view of stage of investigation.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application stands rejected at the stage of investigation.
