Heard Mr. H. Agarwal, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. K. K. Parasar, learned Addl. P.P., Assam appearing for the State.

This is an application under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 praying for pre-arrest bail to the petitioners viz., 1) Smti Anju Mani Bhuyan, 2) Sri Dipak Sah and 3) Sri Lakshman Kumar Yadav in connection with Margherita P.S. Case No.127/2025 registered under Sections 112/303(2)/308(23) of the BNS, 2023 read with Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are the owners of three vehicles which have been intercepted on the apprehension that they were carrying illegal coal without any valid document or permission. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the zimma petitions for the aforesaid vehicles have been allowed and the drivers of the vehicles have also been released on bail. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is an apprehension that the petitioners may be arrested when they approach the authorities for taking zimma of the vehicles and

therefore, this application for pre-arrest bail.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer within 7 (seven) days from today to have their statements recorded and in the event of their arrest in connection with the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail of Rs.10,000/- each with one surety each of the like nature to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.
