ORDER

17.12.2025

This Court had passed the order dated 10.12.2025 enquiring as to how the petitioner had been permitted to run the Bari-Makha Cattle Market (Singra) up to 08.12.2025, when there was no settlement made in favour of the petitioner during the said period.

2. However, no instruction has been provided on behalf of the BTC.

3. On the other hand, Mr. K Gogoi, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State Government submitted that the settlement of market is a transferred subject after the Department of Market and Fairs is looked after by the BTC.
4. This Court has also seen that the said authority i.e. the respondent No.3 had not provided any instruction(s).
5. Considering the above, list this matter again on 07.01.2026.
6. It is observed that if the instruction(s) are not brought on record by way of an affidavit on or before 05.01.2026, the respondent No.3 shall remain present before this Court at 10.30 A.M., through the video conferencing link to be provided by Mr. NR Sarma, the learned Standing Counsel, BTC.
7. It is further observed that in the said affidavit, the respondents shall categorically deal with the query as raised in paragraph 6 of the order dated 10.12.2025.
