2. This is an application under Section 430(2) BNSS for suspending the sentence imposed upon the applicant/appellant on his conviction under Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012 read with Section 377 IPC vide Judgment dated 31.03.2022, passed by the Court of the learned Special Judge (POCSO), Kamrup(M), Guwahati in Sessions Case No.256/2018, arising out of Chandmari P.S. Case No.329/2018.

3. Upon hearing the counsels for the parties at some length, we are of the view that the application cannot be allowed at this stage on account of the evidence of the

victim and the Medical Officer (PW-4).
