Heard Mr. A.T. Sarkar, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. R.J. Baruah, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. By this petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioners, namely, **(i) Ebrahim Sk. @ Kanchu (ii) Abdul Latif Prodhani (ii) Amina Bibi @ Anna Begum (iv) Sajida Khatun (v) Nozimon Khatun @ Noziman Bewa**, have prayed for granting pre-arrest bail, apprehending arrest in connection with Dhubri P.S. Case No. 344/2025 under Section 69/89/118(2)/117(2)/3(5) of BNS, 2023.

3. The case arose out of FIR dated 11.08.2025 lodged by the alleged victim woman. The gist of the allegation is that the petitioner no. 1 aged about 19 years had relationship with her with promise of marriage as a result of which, she also contracted pregnancy and subsequently, consumed medicine for abortion. It is also alleged that the petitioner Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 who are stated to be family members of the petitioner No. 1 brought her to their house on the pretext of arranging the marriage, but subsequently, also physically abused her.

4. Call for the case diary from the concerned police station.

5. In the given facts and circumstances, I deem it proper that at this stage, the present petitioners can be given a chance to record their

statements with some interim protection.

6. Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the accused-petitioners, they shall be released on **interim bail** in connection with Dhubri P.S. Case No. 344/2025 under Section 69/89/118(2)/117(2)/3(5) of BNS, 2023, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.25,000/- each** with one suitable surety **each** of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

7. The direction for bail is further subject to the condition(s) that the accused-petitioners:

- (a) shall render cooperation with the remaining investigation;
- (b) shall not hamper or tamper with evidence;
- (c) shall not try to influence any witnesses;
- (d) shall be available for trial, if one commences; and
- (e) shall not intimidate or harass the informant or her family members.

8. Violation or breach of condition(s) shall entail cancellation of the bail.
