1. Heard Mr. A. T. Sarkar, the learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. P. Borthakur, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State respondent, who submits that the though the case diary was called for in this case, however, in the meanwhile, the charge-sheet has been laid bearing the Charge-sheet No. 418/2025 dated 17.12.2025.
