Heard Mr A. Atreya, learned counsel appearing for the applicant. Also heard Mr. K. K. Parasar, learned Addl. P.P., representing the opposite party.

This is an application for condoning 16 days delay in filing the connected statutory appeal.

Notice in the instant Interlocutory Application was issued and the same was received by the respondent no. 2, as per the record.

The learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that there is no intentional delay in filing the connected statutory appeal and the delay that has occurred is unavoidable and in fact, the time consumed because the connected appeal has been preferred by one of the associates of “Studio Nilima”, a non-profitable organization, engaged in supporting the under-privileged litigants.

This Court had gone through the explanation given in the application and having found the explanation justified, the instant Interlocutory Application is allowed by condoning the delay of 16 days.

In view of the aforesaid, the connected criminal appeal shall be registered

and numbered by the Registry as soon as possible.

Accordingly, the Interlocutory Application is disposed of.
