Heard Shri D. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel for the petitioners.

As per the facts projected, the petitioners had applied for grant of NOC for transfer of land in the year 2025. However, the petitioners were informed of certain errors in the records which were ultimately rectified. However, the process of grant of NOC has not been brought to a logical conclusion. He has also informed that after correction of the records, fresh application has been made on 23.02.2026.

Shri J. Handique, learned State Counsel has submitted that there is a stipulation of 45 days for processing an application for NOC and therefore, from the date of filing of the fresh application, i.e. 23.02.2026, the said period has not expired. Ms. N. Bordoloi, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department has submitted that the writ petition is pre matured and liable to be dismissed.

Be that as it may, as the fresh application has been filed during the pendency of this case only on 23.02.2026, consideration of this writ petition is deferred till 1<sup>st</sup> of April, 2026.

It is however observed that pendency of this writ petition shall not be a bar for processing the application for grant of NOC in accordance with law.
