1. Heard Mr. P. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. R.

J. Baruah, learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

2. This petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed by the petitioner, namely, **(1) Sarban Bibi (2) Abul Hassan and (3) Abul Hassain**, apprehending arrest in connection with **PRC Case No. 547/2025 corresponding to Kachudaram P.S. Case No. 62/2024** registered u/s **61(2)/64/316(2) of BNS**.

3. The gist of allegation in the ejahar lodged by the father of the victim girl is that his daughter's marriage was fixed with accused No.1 of the FIR and during this time the accused No.1 used to come to his house and he had relationship with the informant's daughter causing her pregnant. Subsequently, the accused Nos. 2, 3, 4 and the petitioner herein refused to marry the informant's daughter and later on these petitioners send the main accused in another State.

4. On the prayer of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor in this regard call for the scanned copy of case diary and charge-sheet of the aforementioned case. It is submitted that investigation is completed and the main allegation is against accused No.1.

5. In that circumstances, the petitioners named above, shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail, in connection with the above noted case, on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 25,000/- each** with one surety of like amount each to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject, of course, to the following conditions that the petitioners:

(a) shall co-operate with the investigation and make himself available for examination;

(b) shall not hamper or tamper with the evidence of the case.
