The petitioners are aggrieved by the inaction of the respondent no. 3 to act on the application submitted by the petitioners for demarcation of the land.

This Court vide order dated 07.01.2026 had directed the State to obtain the instructions.

Shri H. Sharma, learned State Counsel, Assam has submitted that written instructions dated 04.02. 2026 have been received as per which, the necessary steps could not be taken as the map of the area in question was found to be in a dilapidated condition. It is also submitted that steps have been taken for providing a new map of the area.
