Heard Mr. N.N.B. Choudhury, learned counsel for the petitioners; Mr. G. Bora, learned Standing Counsel, Agriculture Department for the respondent nos. 1, 3, 6 & 7; Ms. R.M. Baruah, learned counsel on behalf of Mr. A. Chaliha, learned Standing Counsel, Finance Department for the respondent no. 2; and Mr. M.M. Zaman, learned counsel on behalf of Mr. S. Chamaria, learned Standing Counsel, Assam Seeds Corporation Ltd. for the respondent nos. 4, 5, 8 & 9.

2. Seeking a direction to the respondent authorities, more particularly, Assam Seeds Corporation Ltd. authorities, to release an amount of Rs. 15,21,679/-, the instant writ petition is preferred.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 22.04.2026.

As Ms. Bora, learned Standing Counsel, Agriculture Department has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1, 3, 6 & 7; Ms. Baruah, learned counsel has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent no. 2; and Mr. Zaman, learned counsel has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 4, 5, 8 & 9, issuance of formal notices to the said respondents are dispensed with. However, requisite nos. of extra copies of the writ petition along with annexures are to be furnished to Ms. Bora, Ms. Baruah and Mr. Zaman within 2 [two] working days from today.

5. The respondents, more particularly, Assam Seeds Corporation Ltd. shall ensure that its counter affidavits are filed on or before the returnable date traversing the claim of Rs. 15,21,679/- made by the petitioner.

6. On filing of the counter affidavits of the respondents, an endeavour will be made to dispose of the writ petition on the returnable date.
