Heard Mr. I. Rafique, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Ms. S. Baruah, learned Government Advocate, Assam appearing for the respondents.

By way of this application, the applicant is seeking early hearing of the writ petition bearing WP(C) No.6974/2024. It appears that the petitioner by filing the aforesaid writ petition the petitioner has challenged the order dated 19.06.2024 dismissing the petitioner from service and the appellate order dated 19.11.2024 dismissing the appeal preferred by the petitioner. It further appears that the pleadings in the aforesaid writ proceeding have been completed.

Considering the urgency canvassed before this Court and that the writ petition had already been admitted, this interlocutory application stands

allowed by directing the Registry to list the writ petition for hearing on 04.02.2026.
