Heard Ms. S. Chakraborty, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D. Nath, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam appearing for the

respondent Nos. 1 and 3 as well as Mr. G. Baishya, learned Standing Counsel, AG (A & E), Assam appearing for the respondent No. 2.

Matter relates to non payment of leave encashment benefit for 300 days earn leave to the petitioner who retired from service on 30.11.2019 on attaining the age of superannuation at 60 years as Revenue Shristedar in the Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara.

It is seen that the State Government in the General Administration Department vide No. GAG(B).213/22018/110 dated 06.07.2019 already communicated to the respondent No.2 AG (A & E), Assam for payment of such leave encashment benefit to the petitioner which is in his account.
