Heard Ms. S. Chakraborty, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. C. Baruah, learned Standing Counsel, Account General for the respondent no. 2 and Ms. U. Sharma, learned Junior Government Advocate for the respondent no. 3.

The writ petition has been indentified for inclusion in the cause-list under the heading "*For referral the Special Mediation Drive-Mediation 'For the Nation' List*".
