Heard Ms. Ajano, learned counsel for the appellant and Ms. A. Ayemi, learned Government Advocate appearing for the State respondents.

2. By filing this intra-court appeal, the appellant, who is the petitioner in WP(C)/226/2025, has assailed the judgment & order dated 24.03.2026 passed in WP(C)/226/2025, dismissing the writ petition of the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that after release the appellant was taken into custody on 05.10.2025 and on release on bail, the intimation of his release on bail was given by communication dated 02.06.2025. However, beyond the period of 3 (three) months, the Review Committee was constituted to consider the continuous suspension of the petitioner, which took up the proceedings on 16.12.2025. It is projected that charge-sheet in the criminal proceedings was submitted on 23.10.2025. Accordingly, it is submitted that the finding of the learned Single Judge warrants interference.

4. Issue rule returnable in 3 (three) weeks.

5. The learned counsel for the appellant shall serve requisite extra copies of the memo of appeal along with all annexures/enclosures to the learned Government Advocate within 2 (two) days.

6. Liberty is granted to the State respondents to file their affidavit, if so

advised.
