Heard Ms. Z. Zhimomi, learned counsel for the appellant and also heard Mr. C.T. Jamir, learned Sr. Counsel assisted by Ms. Toshi Jamir, learned counsel for the respondent Nos.5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 14, 15 and 16. None appears for the respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Office note, dated 27.01.2026, indicates that the appellant has not taken any steps for service of notice upon the respondents.

Mr. C.T. Jamir, learned Sr. Counsel, has pointed out that vide order dated 21.01.2026, while admitting the appeal, this Court had directed the appellant to take steps upon the respondent Nos. 9, 10, 13 and 17 by way of speed post as well as by usual process within three working days, but, the appellant has not taken any steps as per the said order and on account this, this petition is liable to be dismissed.

However, Ms. Z. Zhimomi, learned counsel for the appellant submits that she will take steps upon the respondent Nos. 9, 10, 13 and 17 though inadvertently the appellants could not take steps.

Accordingly, it is provided that Registry shall list the matter after 4(four) weeks and in the meantime, the appellant shall take steps upon the respondent Nos. 9, 10, 13 and 17 pursuant to the direction issued by this Court vide order dated 21.01.2026.
