Heard Mr. Uttam Deka, learned counsel for the petitioner, who has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of the appropriate writ or order to the respondents, by submitting that the petitioner being aggrieved by the order passed by the President of the District Commission vide Judgment & Order dated 31.10.2025, wishes to file an appeal against the said judgment and order. However, till date, the State respondents have not re-activated the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission, which was previously functioning, but due to the inaction of the respondents, is not functional as on date.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction/order may be passed for the State respondents to take steps for the re-functioning of the State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission.

Having heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, issue notice of motion to the State respondents.

Ms. P. Pangu accepts notice on behalf of the State respondents. No need to issue formal notice. Requisite extra copies of the writ petition to be duly furnished to the learned Government Advocate.
