Heard Mr. N. Rama, learned Counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Taffo, learned Standing Counsel, Apex Bank for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4.

2. This application is filed under Section 115 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 praying for setting aside and quashing of the impugned Money Execution Petition No.13/2020 in connection to award passed in Lok Adalat on 09.03.2019, organised by DLSA Papum Pare District, Yupia.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within 3(three) weeks.

4. Since Mr. Taffo, learned Standing Counsel, Apex Bank, has entered appearance and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 to 4, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, he shall be provided with requisite extra-copy of the petition, if not already served, during the course of the day.

5. The learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps for service of notice

upon respondent No. 5 by registered post with A/D as well as usual process within seven days from today.

6. Considering the submissions of the learned counsels for both sides, the further execution of the impugned Orders dated 12.12.2024 and 06.03.2025, passed in Execution Petition No. 13/2024, and the consequential proceedings of Execution Petition No. 13/2020, in connection with the award passed in the Lok Adalat on 09.03.2019, organized by DLSA Papum Pare District, Yupia, stands stayed until the disposal of the instant petition.
