Heard Mr. C. Modi, learned counsel for the appellant and also heard Mr. U. Bori, learned Additional PP for the State respondents.

The appellant, Mr. Opak Mara, stood convicted in connection with DRJ P.S. Case No. 22/16, under Section 304(I) Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer imprisonment for six years and also to pay a fine of Rs. 1000/- (One thousand) in default sentenced for another six months, vide judgment and order dated 29.05.2018 in BSR/SESS-13/18, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Basar.

After hearing the learned advocates of both sides, the appeal is admitted for hearing.

Issue notice to the respondents returnable in 4(four) weeks.

Since Mr. U. Bori, learned Additional PP, entered appearance on behalf of State respondent No.1 and accepted notice, no formal notice is required to be issued to him. However, requisite extra copy of the petition be furnished to him during the course of the day.

Steps upon respondent no.2 be taken by registered post with A/D as well as by usual process, within 2(two) days from today.

Call for the record from the learned Court below, on receipt of which the Registry shall prepare Paper Book and furnish the copy of the same to the learned counsel for the appellant and also to the learned Additional PP and immediately thereafter, the case to be listed for hearing.

List the matter after 4(four) weeks.
