Heard Mr. B. Chowdhury, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. B. K. Singh, learned counsel respondent Nos. 1 to 5 through virtual mode.

**2.** The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner had executed a work for construction of 1670 MT. capacity Food Grains Godown including

Infrastructural Development at Aalo in the State of Arunachal Pradesh. It is submitted that out of total bills of Rs.5,63,29,413/-, the petitioner has been paid Rs.3,14,00,000/-. However, the remaining amount of Rs.2,56,13,413/- has not yet been paid to the petitioner till date despite repeated request.

**3.** By filing this writ petition, the petitioner is praying for a direction to the respondents to release the outstanding contractual dues amounts of Rs.2,56,13,413/- to the petitioner.

**4.** Issue notice, returnable by 08.06.2026.

**5.** Since Mr. B. K. Singh, learned counsel has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 5, issuance of formal notices is dispensed with. However, requisite extra copy of the writ petition along with the annexures be furnished to him within a week from today.

**6.** The learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon respondent Nos. 6 & 7 by speed post as well as by usual process within a week from today.
