**ORDER**

Heard Mr. Muk Pertin, learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

It is seen that notice upon respondent No. 3 has been served through dasti and affidavit to that effect is accordingly filed.

Mr. S. Tapin, learned senior Government Advocate submits that he will be representing respondent Nos. 1 & 3. None appeared for respondent No. 2. Requisite copies of the writ petition to be duly furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents, if not already done.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that the Order dated 06.06.2024, which is the proceeding of departmental enquiry against the petitioner may be stayed till the final disposal of the instant writ petition, since the petitioner, who is now a pensioner, is facing much difficulty and harassment, having to appear before the Enquiry Officer for Departmental Proceedings which ought to be quashed.

The grant of interim stay is strongly objected by Mr. S. Tapin, learned senior Government Advocate for respondent Nos. 1 & 3 submitting that there is an extension order for appointment of the Enquiry Officer which is dated 5 March, 2024 and he will file the necessary documents by way of an affidavit by the next Court date and that the writ petition is liable to be dismissed since no case is made out in the writ petition.

I have considered the submissions made by both the parties and this Court find it fit to order an interim stay of the order dated 06.06.2024 till the next date of listing.
