Heard Mr. D. Loyi, learned Public Prosecutor, Arunachal Pradesh.

2. This appeal filed by the convict Kaling Mize through the Deputy Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Tezu, is against the judgment & order, dated 30.03.2023, passed by the Sessions Judge, Pasighat, whereby, he has been convicted in PSG Sessions Case No. 06/2021 under part-II of Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code, arising out of Boleng P.S. Case No. 02/2021, to undergo imprisonment for 5 years along with a fine of Rs. 10,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to undergo further imprisonment for a period of 1 year.

3. This is a jail appeal filed through the Deputy Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Tezu. The Office has registered the matter as a Jail Appeal.

4. Since the appellant is unrepresented, Smt. Kipa Rimi, learned legal aid counsel of the High Court Legal Services Committee, is appointed as the legal aid counsel/amicus curiae to represent the appellant at the cost of the Legal Services Authority. The legal aid counsel shall take steps for filing of the proper memorandum of appeal, if necessary.
5. Admit.
6. Call for the relevant trial Court records.
7. Issue notice, returnable within 3 weeks.
8. Since Mr. Loyi, learned Public Prosecutor, has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent State of Arunachal Pradesh; no formal notice need be issued to the said respondent.
9. List it after 3(three) weeks on a date to be fixed by the Registry.
