Ms. N. Handique, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that she may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with a liberty to file afresh.

By filing this writ petition, the petitioner has essentially challenged the suspension order dated 15.04.2025, issued by the Executive Engineer (E), Raga Electrical Division, Department of Power, whereby the petitioner has been placed under suspension on the basis of the report submitted by the Junior Engineer (E), Tamen Electrical Section, alleging that one Lt. Gemi Sakter (Public) died of electrocution on 23.03.2025 at 16 KVA Sub-Station, Kamporijo,

due to the alleged negligence of the petitioner.

Having considered that no materials have been brought on record as regards the challenge to the suspension order, the prayer for withdrawal is accepted.

Mr. L. Perme, learned Standing Counsel, Power Department, is present.

Accordingly, writ petition stands closed on withdrawal with a liberty to file afresh, if so advised.
