By filing this petition, the petitioners have prayed for a direction to the respondent authorities to add the name of the petitioner No. 2, namely, Ms. Techhi Menyo, in the family declaration in the service book of her father late Techhi Peki, who had died in the year 2007 after retirement from his service of Cattle Attendant under the Office of Joint Director, Composite Livestock Farm, Nirjuli, in the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary and Dairy Development, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Nirjuli, after serving the department from 01.03.1972 to 31.03.2007.
