Heard Mr. A. Tatak, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Ms. G. Ete, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate for the 1 to 3.

The challenge made in this writ petition is to the order No. DRG/JUD-4/2024-25 dated 05.09.2024, issued by the Additional Deputy Commissioner, West Kameng District, Dirang, whereby, the Lish/Lish Gompache and Lubrang villages have been directed that the customary norms as prevalent may be continued or followed by both the parties till a final solution is arrived, the flora and fauna to be preserved by all the 3(three) villages, namely, Lubrang/Lhis/Lhis Gompache and directed the parties to maintain status-quo.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable by 3(three) weeks.

As Ms. G. Ete, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, has entered appearance and accepted notice on behalf of State respondent Nos. 1 to 3, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, she shall be provided with requisite extra-copies of the petition during the course of the day, if not already furnished.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon respondent Nos. 4, 5 & 6 by registered post with A/D as well as by *dasti* mode within 3(three) days from today.

The learned Additional Senior Government Advocate is directed to obtain instruction from the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Dirang.

The interim prayer strenuously urged by Mr. A. Tatak, learned counsel for the petitioners shall be considered on the next date.

List the matter after 3(three) weeks.
