Heard Mr. V. Jamoh, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By filing this writ petition, the petitioner has put to challenge the orders dated 02.04.2013, 25.02.2020 and 19.02.2020 issued by the Principle Secretary, Commissioner, under Secretary (Vigilance) whereby the procedure for grant of Vigilance Clearance NOC has been issued providing that to curb the practice of encroachment and demolition, illegal use of public property, it has been decided that Vigilance Clearance to Government officials for promotion and for settling retirement dues, NOC shall be obtained from the concerned Deputy Commissioner, clearly stating

that the Government Officials has not encroached upon any Government property nor has caused any damage or abetted encroachment on the public property by a private person. The petitioner has also prayed for a direction to issue No Objection Certificate/Vigilance Clearance to the petitioner so as to enable him to apply for pensionary and other gratuity benefits after his retirement which is due on 30.09.2025.

Issue notice returnable by 3(three) weeks.

Since Ms G. Ete, learned Additional senior Government Advocate enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, requirement of issuance of formal notice is waived. However, requisite extra copies of the writ petition be served on her during the course of the day.
