Heard Ms. D. Riba, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. T. Jamoh, learned Standing Counsel for respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4, who has submitted a copy of the communication received from the Director of Food and Civil Supplies Department/ respondent No. 2, stating that the department has no objection in accepting the transfer petition of Money Suit No. 05/2025 from the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) Changlang, to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yupia. A copy of the communication is kept on record and

marked as annexure-'X'. Mr. B. K. Singh, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and Ms. P. Sangeeta, learned Government Counsel for respondent No. 3, also have no objections to the prayer of the petitioner.

2. The main ground taken by the petitioner in the present application under Section 24 of CPC is reflected in paragraph Nos. 10, 11 and 12 of the present application.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been having eye problems for many years and he has been regularly taking treatment for the same from time to time. The doctor has ultimately advised for surgery for both eyes, and the surgery was conducted in the month of November, 2025. It is stated that the petitioner is a heart patient and he had undergone a surgery in the year 2013, and he is constantly under medical treatment. The petitioner has been advised to avoid hard labour and regular travelling by the Cardiologist, and therefore, the petitioner has to avoid long journey and he has to periodically go for review check-ups. The relevant medical certificates are annexed in the petition.

4. It is further prayed by the petitioner that the Money Suit No. 05/2025, which is pending between the petitioner and the respondents before the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) Changlang, may be transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yupia, Papum Pare District.

5. As the petition is not objected to by the respondents, the Money Suit No. 05/2025 pending before the Court of the Civil Judge (Senior Division) Changlang, is hereby transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yupia, Papum Pare District.

6. The Registry is directed to do the needful and take necessary steps to transmit this order to the learned trial Court.

7. It is further directed the parties shall appear before the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yupia, Papum Pare District on 06.03.2026.

8. With the above direction and observations, this transfer petition stands allowed and is disposed of.
