ORAL ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Mr.Ashish Dagli for learned advocate Mr.Malay S. Patel appearing on behalf of the applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor Mr. Kathiriya appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.

2. While the present applicant has prayed for being enlarged on regular bail, yet considering the seriousness of the allegations and also having regard to the probability that the present applicant having been wrongly implicated by the complainant just to settled personal scores, more particularly, the complainant being the real sister of the present applicant, learned advocate Mr.Dagli, on instructions, would request this court that the applicant is ready to undergo the process of Naraco Analysis by the Directorate of Forensic Science (for short 'DFS') at his own cost, and whereas, he requests that the DFS may have to conduct the same at an early date.

3. With regard to the above, this Court had directed the learned APP to take instructions and whereas it is informed that the concerned test can be conducted by the DFS within a period of three weeks or as much short period as this Court can direct.

4. Considering the same, it is directed that the DFS shall intimate to the Jail Authorities, Bhavnagar, the date on which the Narco Analysis of the present applicant could be conducted. The present applicant is directed to deposit the fees for such test with the DFS Authorities before test is conducted. Upon the instruction being received, the Jail Authorities at Bhavnagar Jail are directed to arrange for transportation of the applicant from Bhavnagar Jail to the DFS and back.

5. The date for such test shall be conducted on or before the 23.02.2026, and matter to be listed on 27.02.2026, by which time, the result of the test shall be made available to this Court. The DFS is directed to pertinently verify the allegations as regards the present applicant having sexually assaulted the complainant on the dates as mentioned in the complaint or on any other date, i.e. to verify whether the applicant had at any point of time raped the complainant.
