ORDER IN FIRST APPEAL

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that, the Tribunal wrongly assessed the future loss of income and consortium considering the fact that claimant No.1 and 2 were not dependent on the deceased being adult sons of the deceased.

In view of the above, **Admit.**

The Registry is directed to call for record and proceeding from the concerned tribunal without paper book.

ORDER IN CIVIL APPLICATION

Heard learned advocate for the applicant.

Considering the averments made in this application, ad-interim relief in terms of paragraph 7(B) is granted till the disposal of the appeal subject to deposit the entire decretal/awarded amount before the concerned Tribunal within four weeks and upon deposit of the amount, the Court concerned is directed to disburse 30% of the total amount deposited in favour of the claimant/s after proper identification and verification and the

balance 70% amount shall be invested by way of Fixed Deposit receipt with any nationalized bank initially for a period of 3 years and the same shall be renewed from time to time. The Fixed Deposit receipt shall be cumulative. The Fixed Deposit receipt shall be retained by the Nazir Department of the court concerned.

With above direction, the Civil Application stands disposed of.
