1. The grievance of the first informant in the FIR is to the effect that the father of the first informant as well as the accused was holding a property bearing city survey no. 3049. One of the sisters of the parties namely Nayanaben Joshina, had died in the year 2004, and she was having her son. Though the first informant and the other sisters and the heirs of the deceased sister Nayanaben, were alive, the accused persons had prepared a genealogical tree and on the basis of the same, they got their names mutated in the records of city survey.

2. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submitted that thereafter, the parties have resolved the dispute and the names of all the sisters and son of the deceased sister - Sagar Pradyuman Joshi has also been mutated in the city survey records vide entry no. 13843 dated 10.10.2025.

3. Having regard to these aspects, issue Notice returnable on 07.05.2026. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent - State.

4. No coercive steps shall be taken till the next date of hearing.

5. Direct service is permitted.
