ORAL ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Mr. Mohddanish Barejia appearing on behalf of the applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor Mr. Niraj Sharma appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.

2. Considering the submissions made by learned advocates and having regard to the age of the applicant i.e. around 18 years and the age of the prosecutrix being around 17 years, it would prima facie appear that present case is adolescence relationship and whereas this Court has noticed the fact that since the applicant is in custody since 25.10.2025, at this stage, the following directions are passed:

- (1) Notice to respondent No.2 returnable on 09.03.2026. Direct service through the concerned police station as well as through the Speed Post, is permitted.
- (2) The present applicant is ordered to be released on interim bail pending the present application in connection with the FIR being No.11210070250991/2025 registered with Bhestan Police Station,

Surat, on executing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court and subject to the conditions that he shall;

- [a] not take undue advantage of liberty or misuse liberty;
- [b] not act in a manner injurious to the interest of the prosecution;
- [c] surrender passport, if any, to the lower court within a week;
- [d] not leave the State of Gujarat without prior permission of the Sessions Court concerned;
- [e] furnish the present address of residence to the I.O. and also to the Court at the time of execution of the bond and shall not change the residence without prior intimation to the I.O.;
