1. Learned Advocate, Mr. Mohsin Hakim, submitted that he has received instructions to appear on behalf of opponent No.1-original claimant and he seeks time to file his vakalatnama.

1.1 Heard. Registry is directed to accept the vakalatnama of learned Advocate, Mr. Mohsin Hakim, on behalf of Opponent No.1-original claimant.

1.2 Learned Advocate, Mr. Mohsin Hakim, accepts service of rule and waives service qua the original claimant.

2. Insofar as Civil Application (For Stay) No. 1 of 2026 is concerned, learned Counsel for the appellant submitted that 100% of the awarded amount shall be deposited with the concerned learned Tribunal within the period of four weeks,

from today.

2.1 Heard. In view of the above statement made by the learned Counsel for the appellant, the implementation, execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award is **stayed**, on condition of depositing 100% of the awarded amount along with interest, before the concerned learned Tribunal within **four weeks**, from today.

2.2 Upon deposit of the aforesaid amount, 30% of the awarded amount shall be disbursed in favour of the original claimants through RTGS / NEFT after due verification, whereas, the remaining 70% amount shall be invested in FDRs in any nationalized bank, initially, for the period of five years and the same shall be renewed from time-to-time, till final disposal of the captioned appeal. FDRs shall be kept in the safe custody of the Nazir of the concerned learned Tribunal. Though, the claimants shall be entitled to get the amount towards periodical / quarterly interest accrued on the aforesaid amount, but, they shall not be entitled to avail any loan or advance facility against the said amount.

2.3 With the above observations and directions, Civil Application (For Stay) No. 1 of 2026 stands, **disposed of**.
