ORAL ORDER

1. Learned advocate Mr. Kishan Prajapati appearing for the applicants does not press the present Criminal Misc. Application qua the applicant No.1 - Dodhiyar Baluben wd/o Ranchhodji Fulaji.

1.1 Hence, the Criminal Misc. Application stands disposed of qua the applicant No.1 - Dodhiyar Baluben wd/o Ranchhodji Fulaji as not pressed.

2. Heard learned advocate Mr. Kishan Prajapati appearing for the applicants Nos. 2 to 4 and learned APP Ms. Krina Calla appearing for the respondent No.1 - State. Perused the entire materials on record along with the impugned FIR.

3. It appears that the present applicants Nos. 2 to 4 are the

brother-in-law and sisters-in-law respectively of the complainant. On bare perusal of the FIR, it *prima facie* appears that the allegations levelled by the respondent No.2 - complainant against them are vague, omnibus and general in nature. In view of the aforesaid, in the considered opinion of this Court, the application deserves consideration.

4. Hence, **RULE** returnable on **17.07.2026**.

5. Learned APP Ms. Krina Calla waives service of notice of Rule for and on behalf of respondent No.1 - State.

6. In the meantime, let there be an ad-interim relief in terms of paragraph 17(C) qua the applicants Nos. 2 to 4 only, till the next date of hearing.
