1. Heard learned Advocate Ms. R.V. Acharya for the petitioner, who by way of this petition inter alia raises a grievance as regards non-finalization of the pension case of the petitioner on account of the respondent authorities, more particularly respondents No. 4 and 5 not taking a decision as regards the period of leave/unauthorized absence of the present petitioner.

2. Considering the submissions made by learned Advocate Ms. Acharya and perusing a communication by the respondent No.3 to the respondent No.4, it would appear that inspite of appropriate guidance being sought for, from the respondents No. 4 and 5, yet in absence of the same being received, the petitioner having retired a decade ago is finding himself in such an unenviable position.

3. Having regard to the same, issue **Notice** to the respondents returnable on **01.03.2024**. Learned AGP Mr. Ayaan Patel waives service of notice for respondent No.1. Direct service for rest of the respondents is permitted.

4. By the returnable date, the respondents shall provide a time line as regards the decision which would be taken upon the proposal forwarded by the respondent No.3.
