1. RULE. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor waives service of notice of Rule on behalf of respondent–State.
2. By way of this application, the challenge is given to the concurrent findings of conviction and sentence passed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
3. Referring to the judgment of the appellate Court, learned Advocate Mr. Vatsal Ruparel submitted that 40% of the cheque amount has already been deposited by the revisionist. It was, therefore, prayed that the present application may be allowed and the sentence qua the applicant herein may be suspended and the applicant be

granted bail.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor prayed that no discretion may be exercised in favour of the applicant.
5. Heard learned advocates appearing for the respective parties and perused the material on record. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and when an amount has been deposited before the learned Appellate Court and when the Revision Application will take its own time to come for final hearing, the order of sentence requires consideration.
6. In view of the above, the order of sentence dated 12.04.2019 passed by the learned 18th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vadodara in Criminal Case no.30055 of 2017 which was upheld and confirmed by order dated 06.01.2026 passed by the learned 10th Additional Sessions Judge, Vadodara in Criminal Appeal no.99 of 2019 are suspended till disposal of the Revision and the applicant is ordered to be released on bail on executing a personal bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand only) and a surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court concerned and subject to the conditions that the applicant shall:-
 - [a] pursue the matter scrupulously as and when the same is listed;

[b] not take undue advantage of liberty or misuse liberty;

[c] not leave India without prior permission of the Court;

7. Direct service is permitted. Registry to communicate this order to the concerned Court/authority by Fax or Email forthwith.
