The learned AGP Mr. Nikunj Kanara waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1,2,4, whereas the learned counsel Ms. Aishwarya Gupta waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent No.3.

The learned counsel Mr. Abhiji Rathod for the petitioner has filed an additional affidavit, which is taken on record. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in possession of the lands, which are duly leased by the revenue authorities as per the map, which is enclosed with the additional affidavit. He submits that the authorities are trying to evict the petitioner from the same despite lawful use.

The learned counsel Ms. Aishwarya Gupta appearing for the respondent No.3 submits upon instructions that the land of the petitioner is overlapping the land possessed by the respondent No.3 authority to the extent of 60%. She submits that due to overlapping, the respondent authority shall not take any step against the petitioner.
