Mr.Mihir Joshi, learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent no.3-port authority submits that in the present case, the coordinates as provided in the petitions are overlapping and are found to be within the boundary coordinates given by the District Inspector Land Record (DILR) in respect of the lands possessed by the respondent no.3. He, therefore, submits that for

the present, the respondent no.3 shall not take any action in respect of these lands till the requisite clarification is available from the DILR.

4. Learned AGP is directed to file an appropriate reply on behalf of the respondent nos.2 and 4 before the next date of hearing.
