1. Heard Mr. Vikas Nair, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. Rajvi Patel, learned Advocate for the petitioner and Ms. Forum Shah, learned Assistant Government Pleader for the respondent No.4.
2. After arguing for some time, Mr. Nair, learned Advocate, under the instructions of his client, does not press the present petition. Mr. Nair, learned Advocate, requests this Court that some suitable observations may be made that the Trial Court may independently decide the lis between the parties without

being influenced by any of the observations made by the Appellate Court in its impugned order.

3. The request made by Mr. Nair, learned Advocate, is reasonable and requires acceptance.
4. It is hereby observed that while deciding the dispute between the parties, the Trial Court shall adjudicate the suit on its own merits without being influenced by any of the observations made by the Appellate Court in its impugned order while granting the order of status quo.
5. It is made clear that this Court has neither gone into nor examined the merits of the matter.
6. With the aforesaid observations, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed. No order as to costs. Notice is discharged. Interim relief, if any, stands vacated forthwith.
