ORAL JUDGMENT

1. Present Petition is preferred by the Petitioners (Original Accused) under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, seeking quashing of FIR No. 11191035250103 of 2025 registered with Naroda Police Station, Ahmedabad City for the offences punishable under Section of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 118(1), 115(2), 296(b), 351(3), 324(4), 54 of the B.N.S. and Section 135(1) of the G.P. Act.
2. Heard learned Advocate for the Petitioners and learned APP for the Respondent – State. Learned Advocate Mr.Ravi L. Gurchar appears and states that he has received instructions to appear on behalf of Respondent No.2 – Original Complainant and he would be filing his appearance during the course of the day. Registry to accept the Vakalatnama.
3. Rule. Learned APP waives service of notice for and on behalf of the respondent – State and learned Advocate Mr. Mr.Ravi L. Gurchar waives service of Rule on behalf of the Original Complainant.
4. Learned Advocate for the Petitioners submitted that that none of the

petitioners are having any other antecedents, except the petitioner No.1, who is having an antecedent for an offence punishable under the provisions of GST ACT. Learned Advocate for the Petitioners further submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and they are now not willing to proceed with the complaint any further.

5. Leaned Advocate appearing on behalf Original Complainant - , has placed on record the Affidavit dated 17.2.2026. He submitted that matter has been amicably settled between the parties and there is no objection if present Petition is allowed. The relevant paragraph from the Affidavit reads thus:

“2. I say that I have gone through the memo of petition and the facts and grounds stated in the memo of petition are not disputed by me. At the outset I say and submit that the disputes and grievances of both the sides have been amicably settled and I do not wish to prosecute the petitioner any further with respect to the criminal proceedings initiated by me against the petitioner FIR being C.R. No. I - 11191035250103/2025 registered on 01.02.2025 with Naroda Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offences alleged to have committed on 01.05.2025 punishable U/s. 118(1), 115(2), 296(b), 351(3), 324(4), 117(2) And 54 of BNS, 2023 And U/s. 135(1) OF G.P. Act, which is now culminated in Criminal Case No. 1139971/2025 pending before 40th Add. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ahmedabad City pursuant to Charge Sheet No. 88/2025 dated 23.05.2025.

3. I say that the there was no enmity between myself and the present petitioner. In fact, recently, a meeting took place between both are after due deliberations and discussions amongst the family members of both the sides, compromise agreement is arrived at between the parties and therefore I am agreed to support the petitioner in respect of prosecution initiated against the petitioner.

4. In the facts and circumstances as narrated above, I at my free will, wish and desire am stating on oath that I do not wish to prosecute the criminal proceedings with petitioner as the dispute between us has been amicably settled. I state that FIR being C.R. No. I - 11191035250103/2025 registered on 01.02.2025 with Naroda Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offences alleged to have committed on

01.05.2025 punishable U/s. 118(1), 115(2), 296(b), 351(3), 324(4), 117(2) And 54 OF BNS, 2023 And U/s. 135(1) OF G.P. Act, which is now culminated in Criminal Case No. 1139971/2025 pending before 40th Add. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ahmedabad City pursuant to Charge Sheet No. 88/2025 dated 23.05.2025, may be quashed and set aside for which I have no objection, in the interest of justice.”

6. Considering averments made in the Affidavit as also the submissions made by the learned Advocates for the respective parties, the present Application deserves to be allowed and is hereby allowed. The FIR No.11191035250103 registered with Naroda Police Station, Ahmedabad City is hereby quashed and set aside qua the present Petitioners. Rule is made absolute.
