1. Heard learned senior counsel Mr. Jal Unwala with Mr. Jeet Karia appearing for the applicant and learned advocate Mr. Nirav Pandya appearing for the respondent No.1.

2. Considering the averments made in the FIR, more particularly, the allegations are to the effect that despite no meeting having been called, the present applicant had signed the resolution passed in the so-called meeting. However, there are no allegations of forged signature qua the present applicant. Also considering the fact that the said resolution had been challenged before the Charity Commissioner which has been upheld. Also considering the fact that going through the Trust-deed, for calling meeting, 3 trustees would be required out of the total trustees and for giving ratification to any resolution passed in the said meeting, a strength of 50% of the present trustees would be required. Even, considering the fact that two

signatures out of the present trustees are not taken into consideration, three signatures and one being of the present applicant, prima-facie this Court is of the opinion that the interim protection is required.

3. No coercive steps against the present applicant till the next date of hearing.

4. The applicant shall cooperate with the investigation and to remain present for giving statement on 06.04.2026 and any further dates that may be called for investigation.
